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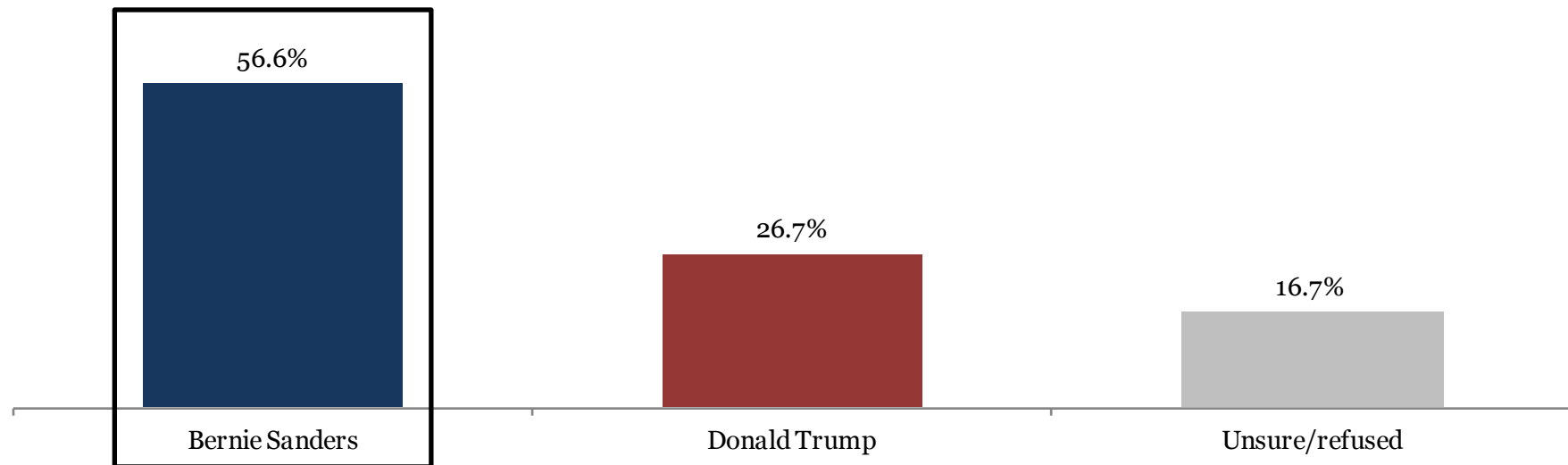

## Over Donald Trump in the race for President

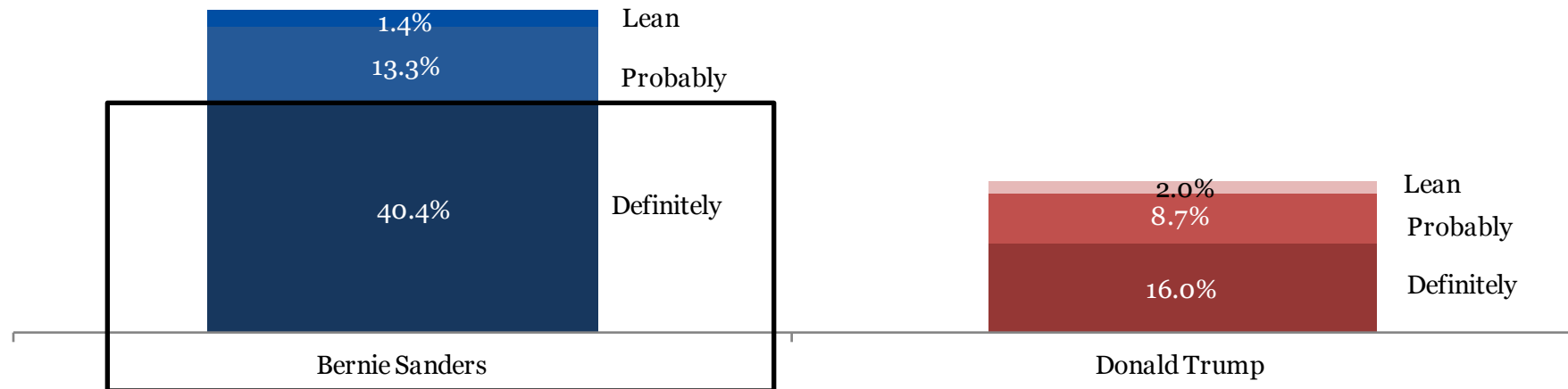

Is considerably higher than that for Trump

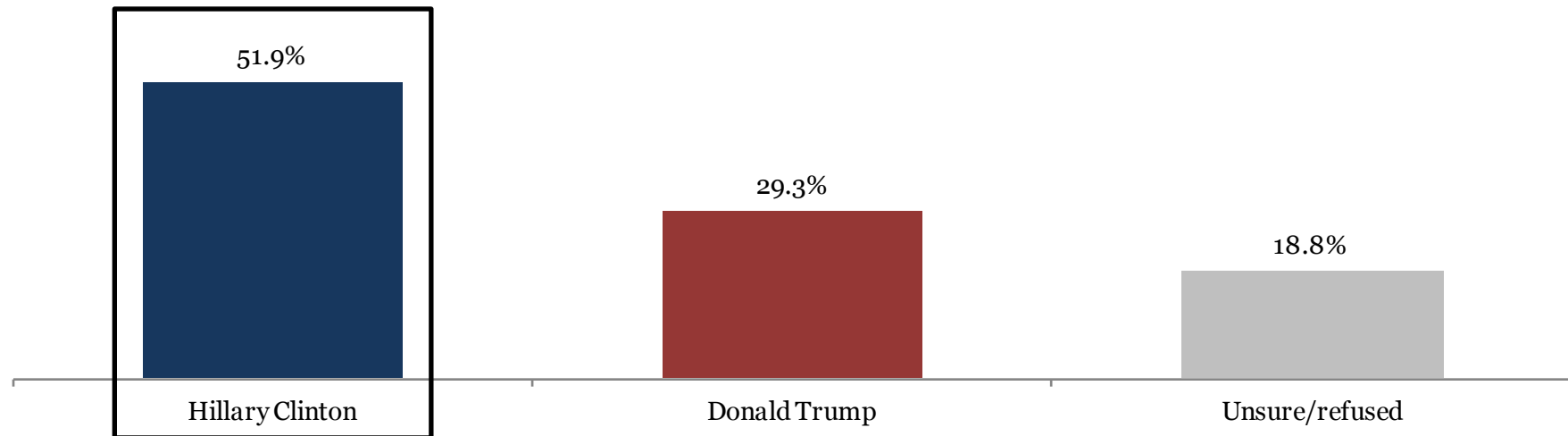

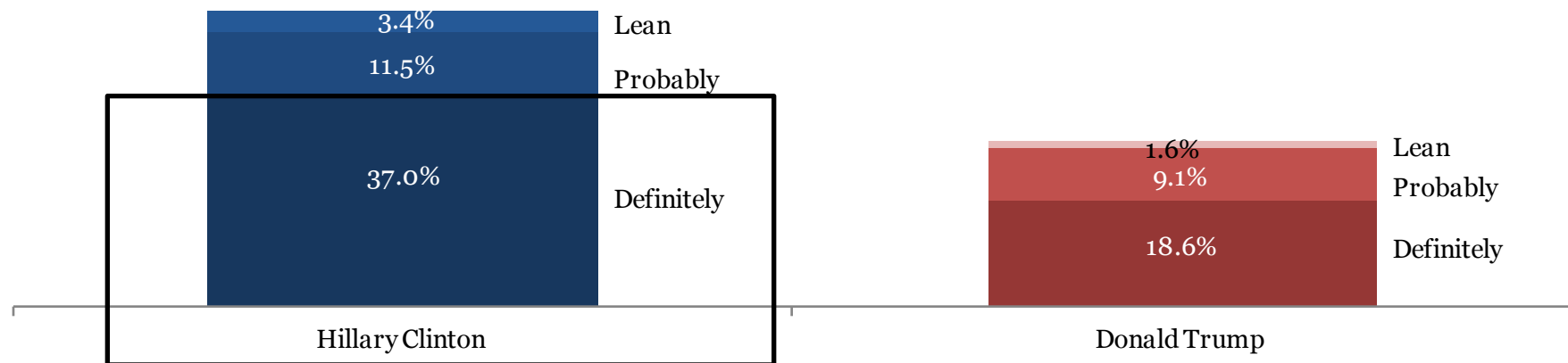




# The intensity of support for Hillary Clinton
